WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

When you join Ogwell FC you join a friendly club that puts players first. You can expect:

- The right to vote at our AGM (May) to elect our committee and an invitation to attend any committee meeting to voice your opinion.
- An Ogwell FC Match kit (U8 upwards) consisting of shirt, shorts & socks. All training kits can be purchased from the Ogwell Online shop. <u>Ogwell Youth Club Shop</u>
- Fun training and participation within Pioneer League matches and friendly matches.
- Social events run by the club.
- The use of "WhatsApp" to disseminate information on fixtures & training to parents. (We use both team and club based groups). (We may use Spond as similar alternative)
- Sponsorship Opportunities

WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU

- RESPECT: All Players & Parents/Guardians/Supporters must follow our Club Rules and Code of Conduct. We reserve the right to withdraw membership for any contravention. We have Respect barriers at matches and it is an expectation that visiting teams or team we visit are treated with Respect also. Swearing, smoking and vaping are not welcome pitchside and we reserve the right to ask supporters to leave if we feel it appropriate for the wellbeing of all.
- COMMUNICATIONS: If for any reason a player cannot attend a session, please send apologies with as much notice as possible to your coach/secretary.
- PUNCTUALITY: Training at Denbury Playing Field, with parking, toilets and tea hut. All teams will train generally for around an hour between 10:00 and 11:30am on a Saturday morning with some teams training mid-week. (Parents/guardians should ensure children arrive in a timely manner to minimise disruption to the training session)
- ATTENDANCE: If a player is regularly absent from training, we may give their place to a new member. (we will have spoken many times before this happens).
- HELP: You will be expected to contribute throughout the season to help the club, coaches and players. This could be in the tea hut, cutting grass/line-marking, grounds, coaching or as a committee member (subject to relevant training). This is your club.
- PAYMENT. Timely payment of subs (see payments).


OUR GROUND (plan overleaf)

We play at Denbury Playing Fields, located between Ogwell & Denbury. We are proud of our facilities which we lease from Denbury Parish Council. Please play your part in keeping them tidy - the general public also use the playing fields and so we need to also be mindful of others.

- Our ground has separate male/female WCs and a Unisex accessible WC (with showering facility)
- Our ground has a tea hut selling food, drinks and sweets, open on training and match days (subject to volunteer availability) We are have a 5 star licence for the sale of hot food and try to offer bacon baps and hot dogs most Saturdays. All proceeds are ploughed back into the Club, so please do support it. Teams all play a part in running the tea hut on a rota basis.
- Our ground has limited parking. On busy match days we may expand parking to include use the gun club (adjacent) or access the ground via the top gate (see map). Please park with this in mind, leaving clear access between the entrance gate and tea hut for emergency access.
- Please consider car sharing, cycling & walking where possible, to save the planet & keep you fit.
- We hold Grounds Days from time to time to tidy up the grounds, paint the buildings etc and help is appreciated.
- Pitches are set out on the map for each age group. We have a rota for cutting the pitches with our tractor/cutter and for line-marking.

PAYMENTS

As would be expected of a volunteer club, we aim to keep our fees low, and affordable for all. Your help with maintenance & upkeep (grass cutting, painting etc). assists with this. We feel that the rates offer fantastic value for money.

- Current annual fees are as follows, these are spread over 9 months (Sept-May).
- We review fees annually and reserve the right to amend.
 - Training only: £120 per annum
 - Training and matches: £162 per annum
- Payment is due on the 1st of each month in advance. If external facilities are hired for Winter training we may ask for additional fees to cover the cost but we will discuss this with you first.
- Bank details, Account number: 23357104, sort code: 20-60-88.
- Matchday/Paypal or Spond app will be used for payments and your secretary will contact you about how to set this up when appropriate.
- Non-Payment of Fees. Our club is a not for profit organisation. In cases of none
 payment your team secretary will remind you and if not paid by next training session,
 the player will not be allowed to attend training or matches until fees are settled.
- We do not guarantee a minimum or maximum number of training sessions, however run
 most weeks weather permitting, save when coaches have holidays with longer breaks in
 the school holidays, although many coaches continue to train to maintain fitness at their
 discretion.
- Injury: If a player is unwell or injured, monthly payments are still due. However if absence is likely to be prolonged then please contact your coaches and dispensation will be discussed.



WHOLE GAME & MATCHDAY

WHOLE GAME SYSTEM

We use the FA Whole Game System to record all details about our players and this is the system we have to use for registration.

To be on Whole Game System and for us to be able to register your child to play with out Club you and your player will need a FAN number.

If you are joining from another Club you will already have a FAN and you can simply provide that FAN to us along with your child's d.o.b so that we can register them with us.

If you are new to football at Club level, then you will need to set up a new FAN. Instructions of how to do this for you and/or your child can be found at end of this document. If you have any difficulty, please contact your Team Secretary.

Once you have a FAN for your child please provide your FAN and d.o.b, your child's FAN and d.o.b, a photo of your child and a contact email address to the Club Secretary to complete registration.

You will be asked for any additional information by your Team Secretary or Club Secretary.

It is your responsibility to keep your FAN and your child's FAN details up to date in Whole Game, this includes, contact information, emergency contact details, medical information etc.

During the registration process you will receive an automatic email from the FA requesting your consent for your child to play for the Club. This will be sent to the email you have provided in Whole Game.

MATCHDAY

Matchday is an app which is automatically populated (from Whole Game) with the squads for each age group. Coaches may use this to organise training and matches. You will also see all the fixtures and results in Matchday. To download the app go to the app store and look for:-


DON'T







Add a Child to you FA account

So, you may have created your own account, but what about your kids? People under the age of 16 will not be allowed to create their own FA account, so luckily until then, you can assign them to yours.

Once you have created an account for yourself, just go to myaccount.thefa.com and sign in. You should see the below screen for this:



After signing in, you will be taken to your account details. Underneath your initial information, there is a section which shows children who can be attached and linked to your account. It will show the children currently linked - whilst giving you a chance to add more by pressing 'Add Another Child'



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When you press 'Add Another Child', you can then fill in the child's name and date of birth that you want to link to your account. Confirm this by clicking 'Add Child'.

The page will then go back to your details and show the new child that you have added linked to your account, generating a FAN for them in the process. This means that you do not have to go through the process of creating a new FA account on behalf of a child.
